



Student Right to an Advisor

The University maintains a pool of trained (non-attorney) advisors who are available to Complainants and Respondents involved in the resolution of complaints filed under the Sexual and Gender-Based Misconduct Policy. The parties may choose advisors from outside the pool, or outside the campus community, but those advisors may not have the same level of insight and training on the campus process as do those trained by the University. Outside advisors are not eligible to be trained by the University. The University has specific rules that apply to the involvement of advisors in the resolution of a complaint.
