All students and dependents considered non-residents for Federal Tax purposes must file the 8843 *even if you did not earn any money in the U.S.* Those who earned income and have to file a 1040NR or 1040NR-EZ should attach the 8843 with their tax return.

1b	Has your visa type changed since you first entered the U.S.? If so, write the visa you have now and when it was changed. If you still have the same visa, write N/A.
2	Write your country of citizenship during 2016. Not sure? What country does your passport page say?
3a	Write the country that gave you the passport.
3b	Check your passport page and find the passport number.
4a	Write the number of days you were inside the U.S. during the years listed. For example, in 2016, if you went home during Winter break for 10 days and during Summer for 45 days, write 310 (365-45=310).
4b	If you have been in F-1 status for less than 5 years, you write the total number of days listed in part 4a for 2016.

Filing deadlines	If you had no U.S. earned income and are filing only Form 8843, the deadline for filing this form is June 1, 2017 . If you must file Form 1040NR-EZ or 1040NR, then you must complete Form 8843 and mail with your tax return before the filing deadline, which is April 18, 2017 .
